

Long Term Care SAFETY INFORMATION

FIRE SAFETY

Fire Code: **CAPTAIN RED**

Activate R.A.C.E.

R = Rescue anyone from immediate danger

A = Alarm - Pull Alarm and dial "66"

C = Contain - Close windows & doors

E = Evacuate - general staff; **Extinguish** - fire team

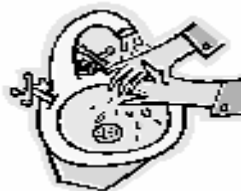
If evacuation is necessary, use horizontal evacuation first.



HANDWASHING

HANDWASHING is the single most important means of preventing the spread of infection.

1. Wet hands and apply soap
2. Lather and rub vigorously for 30 seconds
3. Rinse hands thoroughly under running water
4. Dry hands with paper towel
5. Turn faucet off with dry paper towel

BLOODBORNE PATHOGEN EXPOSURE PLAN



S = Stop and tend to your exposure

T = Tell your supervisor as soon as possible

I = Information will be needed on the source

C = Call or visit Employee Health within 1 hr

K = Keep your follow up appointments

Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) contain information about hazardous chemicals in the workplace.

1. Call 1-800-451-8346
2. Identify yourself and your Hospital
3. Give chemical name and information
4. Give them your fax number
5. The MSDS will be faxed to you immediately
